Mahoney, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any General or Special Law. Therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Terecentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Michael J. Mahoney, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Helen M. Mahoney, widow of Michael J. Mahoney, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.
