**ORDERED:** That the City Manager be requested to confer with the City Solicitor and the Board of Assessors in order to draft a legislative proposal that would allow individuals who qualify for Home Improvement Assistance under the City's various programs to rehabilitate their homes without having their assessment raised until a grace period of several years has elapsed; and be it further

**ORDERED:** That the City Manager be requested to prepare this legislation over the next six weeks so that he can present it to the newly elected City Council after the January Inauguration.
