WHEREAS: Once again, concern has been expressed by some residents living in the area which abuts Central Square about acts of public drunkenness and loitering with the accompanying hassle, aggravation and uneasiness about their personal safety; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Police Commissioner to target that area with increased surveillance of the problems cited for a 6-week period, beginning as soon as possible, and provide a report upon its completion to this Council of the number of citations and/or arrests made in that area during the designated period. Further, that along with the report and on the basis of its content, Commissioner Anderson offer his best judgment as to whether there is need to make the city ordinance which governs drunkenness and loitering more restrictive; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager confirm to the Council by December 23, 1991 the date when the surveillance period will begin to assure that within two (2) weeks after its completion, the Council will have Commissioner Anderson's report and recommendation.
