A communication has been received from Metropolitan District Commission advising the City Council of its intention to install bubbler drinking fountains and requesting the City of Cambridge to furnish water for the fountains to be installed at the following locations:-

1. At Lowell Park in Cambridge. This installation was requested by the Cambridge City Council.
2. At the public tennis courts at the junction of Magazine Street and Memorial Drive.
3. On the water side of Memorial Drive about opposite Wadsworth Street.

That the Water Board be and hereby is requested to furnish water to Metropolitan District Commission to be used in bubbler fountains to be installed at the aforesaid locations.

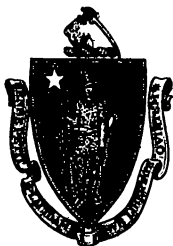

Dear Sir:

With the intention of providing more bubbler drinking fountains for the use of the public on Memorial Drive in Cambridge, I have recommended and the Commission has approved the installation of three bubbler fountains at the following locations.

1. At Lowell Park in Cambridge. This installation was requested by the Cambridge City Council.
2. At the public tennis courts at the junction of Magazine Street and Memorial Drive.
3. On the water side of Memorial Drive about opposite Wadsworth Street.

All these locations are in Cambridge.

The Commission has requested that I find out from you whether the City of Cambridge will furnish the water for these fountains, and has instructed me, in the event that Cambridge will furnish the water, to install these fountains as soon as possible.
