

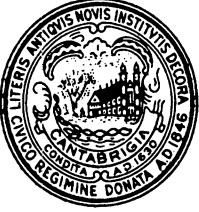
This transfer is necessary in order to pay for unexpected legal fees incurred by various city departments.


