Councillor Vellucci has requested the City Clerk to communicate with you again to appraise you of his impatience regarding the presentation of a revised draft for legislative action, providing for temporary housing for homeless families on M.D.C. land located at the J.F.K. Memorial Park fronting on Memorial Drive. I have enclosed a copy of the latest draft submitted by your office for your guidance in this matter.

Councillor Vellucci desires instant action in this regard and has indicated that he won't rest until this draft is presented. Furthermore, he stated that he would embark on a haunting session of all concerned until this matter is resolved to his satisfaction.

Knowing your desire for peace and quiet in your suburban retreat overlooking the gentle breezes of Fresh Pond, the possibility of haunting in the neighborhood will have an adverse effect on property values in general.

Your kind understanding of the gravity of this matter, together with a revised draft will be of great benefit to this staff, the members of the Council and all others concerned.

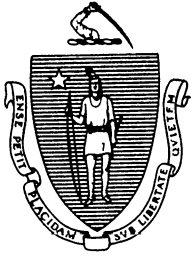

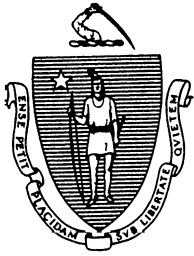

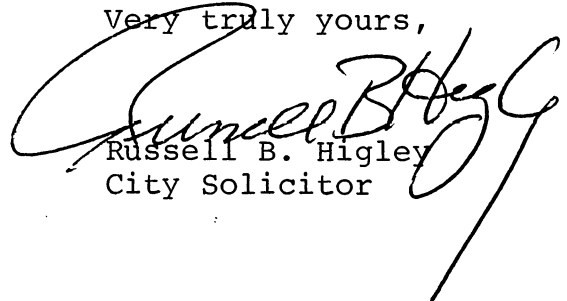
