Seventy five.

An Ordinance in amendment of the Ordinance in
relation to Streets.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows,

Section 26 of Chapter 25 is hereby amended,
by striking out all after the word "therefrom"
in the ninth line, and inserting in place
thereof the words within twenty-four hours
after the snow shall cease to fall; and any
ice which encumbers such sidewalk or any
part thereof, to be removed or covered with sand
or other suitable substance, so as to make such
sidewalk safe and convenient; and if he fails
to do so, he shall forfeit and pay a sum
not less than two dollars nor more than
twenty dollars
