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City of Cambridge

The Committee on Transportation and Parking conducted a public hearing on Wednesday, June 20, 1990 beginning at 6:05 p. m. in the Ackermann Room, City Hall.

Members present were Councillor Sheila Russell, Councillor Timothy Toomey and City Clerk Joseph E. Connarton.

Councillor Russell, Chair of the Committee, opened the hearing by stating she had convened this meeting at the request of residents of the Jefferson Street and Kirkland Street area in order to discuss vehicular and truck traffic problems within the respective areas.

The Committee heard from Ms. Donna Pritchard, 28 Jefferson Street, who served as spokesperson for the twenty-three neighborhood residents who attend the hearing. She outlined the concern of the neighborhood relative to the on going problem of vehicular and truck traffic on Jefferson Street, Warren Street and Marion Street.

The residents requested that Jefferson Street be made a one-way from Warren Street to Marion Street and that Jefferson Street from Harding Street to Marion Street be made one way. Ms. Pritchard stated that this would allow all vehicular and truck traffic to exit from Marion Street on to Cambridge Street.

Mr. Lauren Preston, Deputy Director of Traffic and Parking, outlined the written procedure necessary for the Traffic Department to initiate a post card survey of the neighborhood which could ultimately result in the changing of the traffic pattern on Jefferson Street as requested by the residents.

Councillor Russell suggested the possibility that the Traffic Department could conduct a door to door survey of the neighborhood to expedite the process.

Mr. Preston responded that such a survey may not result in the best possible response and is quite time consuming.

Councillor Russell suggested that the residents initiate the necessary petition immediately and forward same to the City Clerk.

At this time Councillor Russell requested the residents of Kirkland Street to come forward to discuss their problems with vehicular and truck traffic. No one appeared.

Councillor Toomey moved adjournment and the motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at six o'clock and thirty-two minutes p. m.
