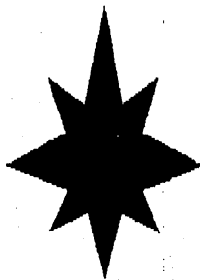

Date: Sunday, August 23

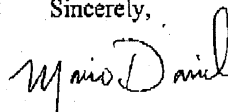

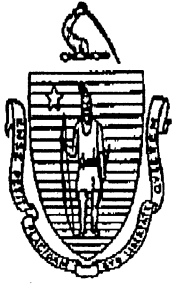
