- WHEREAS: Certain residents of 34 and 37 Jackson Street have raised concerns regarding the quality of craftsmanship of the work recently done at this location; and
- WHEREAS: These complaints are the result of many sleepless nights of adults and their infant children who are awoken during the evening and early morning hours by abnormal noise levels including continuous running water, loud music, etc.; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Executive Director of the Cambridge Housing Authority to personally review this situation and to confer with the residents of 34 and 37 Jackson Place in an effort to resolve this unhealthy and annoying situation and to report back to this City Council as soon as possible the action taken by him pursuant to this resolution.
