WHEREAS:-

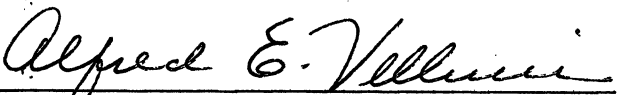
Fine co-operation has existed between ALL of the City Departments and the Charles River Wheelman in the past and will continue into the future; now therefore be it
