To whom it may concern:

Property owners on Bow and Arrow Streets continue to be concerned and threatened by disruption in the area of "Father's Six" bar. We ask you to consider this letter as a formal request that:

Bow and Arrow Streets be more routinely patrolled by the Cambridge Police, particularly just before and just after the bar opens and closes;

that parking provisions on Bow Street be more vigorously enforced.

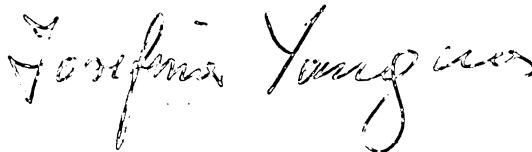
It is legal to park on one side of Bow Street only. A great deal of disruption is caused by bar patrons coming and going from illegally parked cars. These cars are prime targets for vandalism which threatens adjacent property (on at least two occasions Bow Street residents have witnessed car windows being smashed). Cars also provide a magnet for streetfights. Routes for fire trucks and other emergency rescue vehicles are significantly hindered by the presence of illegally parked cars on Bow Street.

This is the third letter of complaint signed by us in as many years. During that time disruption was greatly lessened when parking provisions were enforced (following a letter of complaint dated October 5, 1973). When patrols have been less routine, we have been subjected to street fighting, public drunkenness, property damage, business loss and constant threats to our personal safety and the safety of our customers.

We will expect to hear by return mail your intentions regarding the Bow Street situation.
