Subject City Council Order #3 of October 31, 1977--Speed Limit Reduction On
Huron Ave. from Grove St. to Fresh Pond Parkway

The Traffic and Parking Department conducted a speed study on Huron Avenue for the purpose of lowering the speed limit which according to State Statute was 30 MPH. After completing the study, a request was submitted to the State Department of Public Works and the Registry of Motor Vehicles to allow us to lower the speed limit.

The results of this action was a permit allowing us to lower the legal speed limit to 25 MPH, this law has since been promulgated and signs have been posted.

In order to post an area 20 MPH, it must be in a school zone and meet all the requirements of the State Law and this area would not meet these requirements and therefore we were permitted to post the 25 MPH speed limit signs.

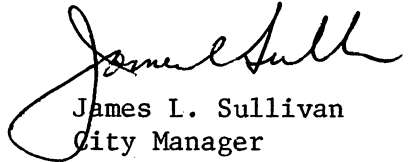
