AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an ordinance formerly entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge" as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter 2 entitled: "Administration", Section 2-181 entitled: "Bonds for performance of contract" is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

Any contract exceeding Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars for any work to be done for the City, may be required to be accompanied by a bond with sureties satisfactory to the board or official having the matter in charge, or by a deposit of money, certified check or other security for the faithful performance thereof.

The entire section will then read as follows:

Sec. 2-181. Bonds for performance of contract:

Any contract exceeding Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars for any work to be done for the City, may be required to be accompanied by a bond with sureties satisfactory to the board or official having the matter in charge, or by a deposit of money, certified check or other security for the faithful performance thereof. No proposal shall be accepted from or offered to any person who has breached a contract with the City during the three (3) years preceding. All written contracts shall be executed in quadruplicate, and one (1) of the copies shall be deposited with the Auditor.
