That the City Treasurer is authorized, with the approval of the City Manager, to borrow from time to time during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1981, a sum or sums in the aggregate not exceeding Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000) for the purpose of meeting the current expenses of the City on temporary loans in anticipation of the revenue of said financial year and to issue notes of the City therefor under General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4 as amended, and to refund the same.

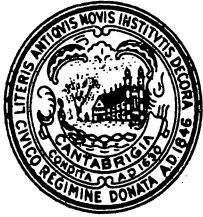


