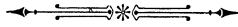

In Board of Aldermen, Oct. 22 1885

Ordered,
That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be and hereby is authorized and directed to cause the removal of the round stone paving on the southerly side of the railroad track on Main Street from West Boston Bridge as far as said paving extends; - and replace the same with granite blocks. The expense thereof not to exceed the sum of \$3000. - to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, Paving.
