COUNCILLOR DANEHY

- WHEREAS: This City Council was recently made aware of a tragic death, which occurred on April 16, 1984 of an elderly woman who resided at 50 Churchill Avenue, Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: At the outset of the ensuing investigation, concern was prevalent from members of the Cambridge Detective Bureau that foul play was the result of the woman's death, as opposed to an early theory of suicide; and
- WHEREAS: Through the diligent efforts of Detective Lieutenant Walter Boyle, Detective Sergeant Fidele Centrella, Detectives Ronald Kenneally and John Jones, along with State Police Detective Lieutenant Thomas Spartachino, a suspect in this homicide was taken into custody just twelve days after the crime, on April 24, 1984, and is currently awaiting trial; and
- WHEREAS: This arrest was the result of an extensive investigation and interviews of the residents of the complex in which the woman resided, and as a result of said arrest, the residents of the complex feel relieved that once again their safety is assured and they can now put their lives back in order; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere gratitude for a job "well done" to each above mentioned officer for their tireless efforts in completing this investigation and bringing into custody a prime suspect; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Walter Boyle, Detective Sergeant Fidele Centrella, Detectives Ronald Kenneally and John Jones, along with State Police Detective Lieutenant Thomas Spartachino on behalf of the entire City Council and to further forward a copy of said resolution to Police Chief Anthony Paolillo for inclusion in their personnel files and to District Attorney Scott Harshbarger for inclusion in Detective Lieutenant Spartachino's personnel file.

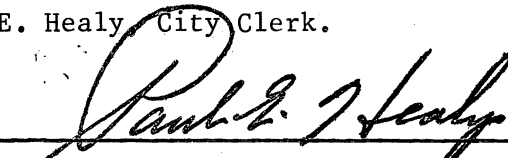
