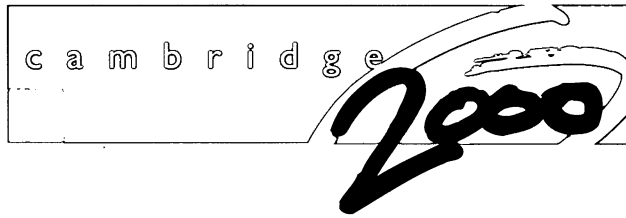

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$204,749.25 in the Public Investment Fund of the Community Development Extraordinary Expenditures Account. As part of its Affordable Housing Development activities, the Community Development Department makes loans of CDBG funds to eligible individuals and organizations for housing improvements. Program income is generated by repayment of CDBG loans and is required to be returned to the CDBG program for reuse on eligible activities. Funds will provide significant financial support to new affordable housing development for low and moderate income residents of the City.
