WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the recent death of Ralph J. Darling, a life-long Cantabrigian on February 6, 1983 at the age of sixty-four years; and

WHEREAS: Ralph J. Darling entered the service of the City of Cambridge on June 22, 1943, commencing a career of thirty-five years of service, achieving the rank of Supervisor of the Fire Alarm Department of the City of Cambridge and serving in that capacity until his retirement on December 2, 1978; and

WHEREAS: Ralph J. Darling was a veteran of World War II, serving with the United States Army from 1941 to 1943 and was active both in civic and community affairs, serving in the position of past Commander of the American Legion Post No. 27, as well as being a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post No. 8818; and

WHEREAS: Ralph J. Darling will be greatly missed not only by his family, but by his many friends and associates throughout the Cambridge community; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Louise Darling and her two children, Toby and Lesley Darling, at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
