- WHEREAS: The mission of the American Red Cross is to help people avoid, prepare for and cope with emergencies; to improve the quality of human life; and to enhance self-reliance and concern for others; through services which are governed by volunteers and consistent with the principles of the International Red Cross; and
- WHEREAS: The American Red Cross provides emergency care, food, clothing, and shelter to families temporarily displaced by fire, flood, and other disasters; and
- WHEREAS: The American Red Cross helped our Sister City Yerevan and other cities in Armenia after last year's earthquake; and
- WHEREAS: The American Red Cross assists current and veteran military personnel and their families to relay thousands of messages of birth, death, and illness to military posts worldwide; and
- WHEREAS: The American Red Cross maintains a not-for-profit blood system which depends solely on volunteer donors, consistent with the principles of the American National Red Cross; and
- WHEREAS: The American Red Cross continues to disseminate information concerning the prevention of the spread of the AIDS virus and fights hazards to health and safety by training in first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, occupational safety, and water safety; and
- WHEREAS: The American Red Cross is constantly changing and updating its program to meet the unique needs of the local community, largely through extensive voluntary support; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alice K. Wolf, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, do hereby join with the entire Cambridge community in proclaiming March 1990 AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH in the City of Cambridge, and I urge all my fellow Cantabridgians to join me in recognizing this outstanding organization and its contribution in adding to the quality of life in our City.
