
To the Honorable, the City Council:

I transmit herewith for review of the City Council a Comprehensive Manpower Plan for Fiscal Year 1975. This Plan will enable the City of Cambridge to receive funding for employment and training programs operated by the Eastern Middlesex Human Resource Development Authority (EMHRDA). The EMHRDA is the prime sponsor agency established through a joint sponsorship agreement between the communities of Cambridge, Somerville, Arlington, Belmont and Watertown.

Over the past five years the City of Cambridge made substantial progress toward implementing an operational manpower program in partnership with the Towns of Arlington, Belmont, Watertown and the City of Somerville. It is this cooperation which led to the agreement to jointly apply for manpower program funding under the CETA legislation. Through this agreement the five communities established the EMHRDA. The City of Cambridge serves as administrative arm for the EMHRDA and, therefore, is responsible for accepting and disbursing federal funds for each participating community. With our designation as administrative arm, the City of Cambridge can expect to receive close to \$2million on behalf of the member communities of this sponsorship consortium. During the next year we shall redistribute to our partner communities nearly two-thirds of the monies to be received under this plan.

In the next month your approval of federal contracts made under this plan shall be required before action can be taken to disburse funds to each of the participating communities.
