WHEREAS: His Honor, the Mayor, has proclaimed the month of April, 1987 as FAIR HOUSING MONTH in Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council urge all people of Cambridge to take notice of this event, and during this 19th Anniversary take the time to review and renew their commitment to fulfilling the American promise of individual equality and fair housing freedom of choice; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is hereby requested to forward a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development.
