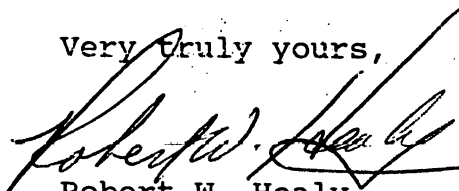

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$113,143.00 to the grant fund from the Massachusetts Department of Public Welfare to the Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$112,731.00) and Travel & Training Account (\$412.00) to provide funds for housing search services for Welfare eligible clients. The program includes assisting homeless families in locating and securing housing, prevention services for families at risk of becoming homeless, and stabilization services for those families that have been housed through the program. This particular contract calls for placement of forty eight (48) homeless families into permanent housing.
