WHEREAS: Brookline Street is a street with a mix of residential and industrial uses, which with the addition of the University Park housing, it will become increasingly residential; and

WHEREAS: The street itself is in some need of repair, and in addition there are some things which can be done to improve the aesthetics of the street as well, such as tree planting; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works to continue plans to make repairs on Brookline Street in June; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be requested to convene a group of people including representatives from D.P.W., the City Arborist, and other interested parties to develop a more comprehensive view of how improvements to Brookline Street can be made, and to report back to the City Council.
