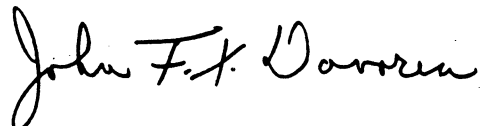

The above-named incorporator(s) do hereby associate (themselves) with the intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180 and hereby state(s):

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

Walden Square Children's Center, Inc.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:
The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and in this connection to care for and assist in the maintenance of children whose parents or guardians are forced to work for a living, by providing for such children, shelter, care, and food during the daytime when their parents or guardians are employed in places of business; to raise the standards of homelife; and to provide the nexis between families and existing social services in the community; and to these ends to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, grant, purchase, lease, or otherwise any property, real, personal, tangible, or intangible, or any undivided interest therein, without limitation as to amount or value; to sell or convey or otherwise dispose of any such property and to invest, reinvest, or deal with the principal or the income thereof in such manner as, in the judgement of the Directors, will best promote the purposes of the Corporation without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received, these Articles of Organization, the By-laws of the Corporation, or any laws applicable thereto.

NOTE: If the corporation is to be organized in a foreign country, the name of the country shall be stated here.

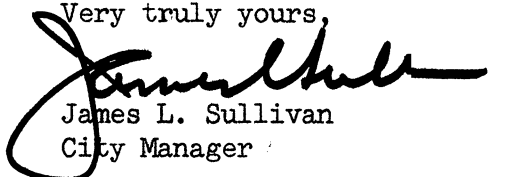
