PAGING NETWORK OF MASS., INC.

Paging Network of Massachusetts, Inc. ("PageNet") seeks authority to provide radio paging service to the following additional service areas in Massachusetts: Ware, West Dudley, Vineyard Haven, Nantucket, Provincetown, Athol, and Amesbury. In order to provide this extended service, PageNet would construct and operate transmitter facilities.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of Paging Network, Inc. to the Department of Public Utilities, under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to extend the operation of a Mobile Radio Utility System for compensation within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing at its hearing room, 1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts, on Wednesday, October 10, 1990 at 10:00 a.m.

The petitioner, Paging Network of Massachusetts, Inc., is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once, at least thirty (30) days prior to said date in the Cape Cod Times (Hyannis), the Worcester Telegram (Worcester), and the Haverhill Gazette (Haverhill), and to serve a copy hereof at least thirty (30) days prior to said date on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
