

Here after no wooden sidewalks shall be placed on any of the sidewalks of the city without first petitioning the Mayor and Aldermen and getting their consent thereto - and no sidewalk so laid shall be less than five feet in width ^{not more than} in sections ^{for covering} twelve feet in length. The material used ^{shall be of pine} and not less than one and a quarter in ^{and planed on one side} not over two inches in thickness, and crossed in every three feet with two by six inch pine ^{boards} - and constructed in every particular as shown on a plan in the office of the City Engineer all sidewalks here by laid shall be subject to the approval of the standing Committee on Roads and Bridges and superintended of street - and may be removed by them when in their judgment ^{deem} the public safety may require it. no exception shall be made to the above requirements except in case where the

Sidewalk is not wide enough to permit of the above described width in such case the standing committee shall have authority to make and allow any necessary change
