Special Programs & Projects

The **Area IV Fall Monthly Lecture Series** is to aware young people and the community of the issues facing the city, Greater Boston, and the world at large through lectures by leaders in community, business, and education. Every Third Thursday of Every Month.

The **Area IV Art & History Gallery** - Community & Youth Meeting Room is for the perseverance of local art and history in Cambridge. 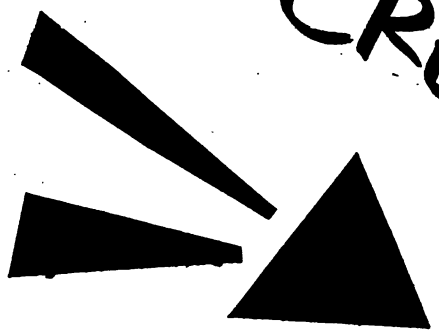

Summer Program Activity Summary

The following summary includes brief descriptions of each program component and a calendar of events youth members were engaged in during the Area IV Youth Center 7 week summer program.

The Area IV Summer Basketball League

The Summer Basketball League has a 10 year history at Sennott Park in the Area IV neighborhood. The Area IV Summer Basketball League provides instruction, teamwork, and organized summer recreation for youth members ages 9 - 19 across the city.

The New Block Day Camp

New Block Day Camp organized by Maynard Community Schools serviced a total of 50 young people ages 9-12 in the Area IV neighborhood. The camp sponsored summer recreational activities for youth : Beach Trips, Arts & Crafts, Rollerskating, Pool Trips, and many other activities.

Area IV Youth Center Program Development Interns

The Area IV Youth Center in conjunction with the Mayor's Summer Youth Employment Program - seven young people in Cambridge (program development interns) summer project was to prepare a needs assessment for young people in the city of Cambridge. The Area IV Program Development Interns identified several issues facing today's youth, viewed current newspapers, researched newspaper clippings at the library. Interns visited youth facilities in Greater Boston, the Teen Center Hotline, Cambridge Police Station, City Hall, and Community Development Department.

Membership Orientation

An Area IV Youth Center Membership Orientation was introduced in July. Each youth member must complete an orientation to complete membership where staff informed all members the rules and regulations of the center. Each youth member is required to sign a membership agreement with the center.

Citywide Coed Softball

A citywide youth center collaboration program designed to promote young men and women building teamwork, and sportspersonship in softball.

Video Production Summer Project

This video production summer project in conjunction with Community Art Center provided skill and technique development in the production of video.

Youth center members watched several videos, and even produced a complete show on Cambridge Community Television.

Summer Educational Seminar

The Educational Seminar was initially an idea to supplement the Area IV Summer Basketball League. The seminar became an event for all members to receive information from local college students on resume writing, job information, leadership development, and program support services.

Summer Field Trips

The Summer Field Trips included trips to Riverside Amusement Park, Water Country, Movie "Poetic Justice", Omni Theatre, and several beach trips. These trips were in collaborations with other youth centers.

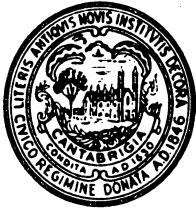
