- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of the Reverend Charles B. Murphy, retired Pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Holbrook; and
- WHEREAS: Father Murphy, a native of Newton, studied for the priesthood at St. John's Seminary, Brighton and at the North American College in Rome, being ordained in 1933 at the Vatican; and
- WHEREAS: Father Murphy held several parish assignments, including St. Peter's, Cambridge; St. Paul's, Cambridge; and St. Cecelia's in Boston, prior to being appointed Pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Holbrook, on February 8, 1960, an assignment he maintained until his retirement from parish ministry, twenty-one years later; and
- WHEREAS: Father Murphy was a priest's priest, devoted to attending to the spiritual needs of the community to which he was assigned, always making himself available to anyone who sought his assistance; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the entire Murphy family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
