- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Joseph F. O'Connell, former State Deputy Budget Director and life long Cantabrigian on February 8, 1983 at the age of eighty-six years; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph F. O'Connell served his country during the First World War in the United States Navy and upon graduation from Boston University, he completed his graduate studies at Bentley College; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph F. O'Connell began a career of public service with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts during the administration of Governor Charles F. Hurley and his outstanding achievements and abilities led to his appointment by Governor Endicott Peabody to the post of Deputy Budget Director, a position which he held until his retirement in 1966; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. O'Connell was active in community and civic affairs, serving in such capacities as past Director of the State Employees Credit Union, Director of the Commonwealth Cooperative Bank, past President of the St. John's Holy Name Society and North Cambridge Council Knights of Columbus, he was also a member of the American Association of Public Accountants, the Gridiron Club of Greater Boston and was a founding member of the Knights of Matignon, the Alumni Association of Matignon High School in North Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Loretta O'Connell and the entire O'Connell family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. O'Connell on behalf of the entire City Council.
