

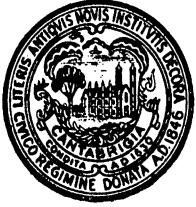

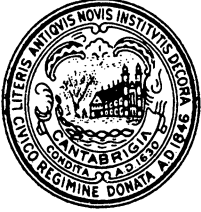

This memo is to request an additional appropriation from the Russell School Fund to complete the Russell School Site Park Project. The funds are needed to complete the pedestrian walkway from the park to Grozier Road. The items and amounts are as follows:

2. Conc. pavers for walkway (balance due from original contract change order)	764.35
3. Evergreen hedge along easement	1,875.00
