- WHEREAS: An armed robbery took place on December 30, 1976 at the Pearl Street Market in which two individuals brandishing a handgun and a knife were arrested by Cambridge Police Officers shortly after the crime, and
- WHEREAS: This crime resulted in a chase by Police through the Brookline, Auburn, Pearl and Watson Street area where one suspect was apprehended, and
- WHEREAS: This arrest was a result of comprehensive Police work by Officers John White, Jr., William Maillet, Kevin Davis, James Dwyer, Michael Downey, Joseph Ferreria, William Gampstead, James Grady, David L. Weaner, Lenny Beal, Detective Rubin Dottin and Detective Thomas Benson all of whom worked jointly to apprehend this suspect, and
- WHEREAS: Upon completion of a thorough investigation a second suspect was captured shortly after this crime by Detectives John Kosenski and Leonard Savignaro, and
- WHEREAS: This capture of the two suspects who were later positively identified by witnesses at the scene of the crime was an example of what dedicated and professional Police Officers we have in this City, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere congratulations to all of the above named Police Officers for their outstanding Police work, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare suitably engrossed copies of this resolution to the Chief of Police for inclusion in their personnel file.
