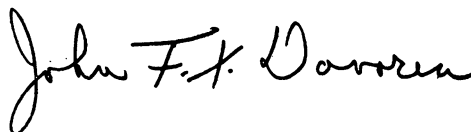

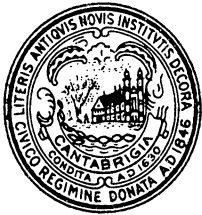

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows: The purposes of this association shall be to work for the restoration and maintenance of clean water and the wise use and proper management of water and related natural resources in the Mystic River watershed; to acquire land or rights in land for conservation purposes and to assist and encourage other organizations and public agencies to do the same within the watershed; to establish and promote programs of public information and education and scientific research related to the aims of this association; and to assist in the coordination of similar efforts by other organizations, individuals, public agencies, and public officials. To accomplish these purposes, the corporation may solicit, receive and borrow, with or without security, real and personal property, including funds, by way of gifts, contributions and subscriptions, and administer, hold, convey, transfer, disburse, lend and sell the same for charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes as are permitted by section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States as it now exists and as hereafter amended, and no assets of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private individual. Upon dissolution and winding up of this corporation, any remaining assets shall be transferred only to an organization having like charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes as are permitted by section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States. No assets shall be conveyed or distributed to any individual or any organization created or operated for profit. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation take part in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

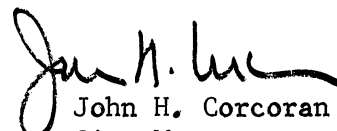
