*Parents and community members are invited to join the students and staff for the school's annual Earth Day Yard cleanup.

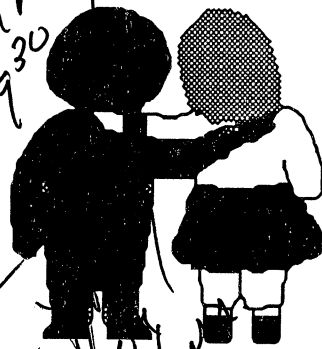
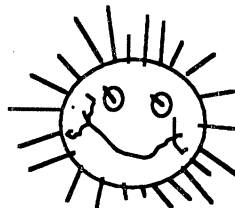
