Dear Mr. Sullivan:

With reference to the order of the City Council dated January 27, 1969 concerning a proposed contract with Service Master Corporation at Cambridge City Hospital, this department has no correspondence concerning such a report. This department did advise the Commissioner of Health, Hospital and Welfare on January 24, 1969 orally that while the law does not require public bidding on a contract for services, nevertheless in the prudent administration of municipal affairs there should be public bidding on such a contract. Further this department at the same time recommended that prior to the institution of bidding, the Commissioner confer with the Director of Civil Service to discuss problems under the Civil Service law that such a contract may raise. The Commissioner advises me that he will deliver any documents concerning the proposed contract to the City Council on February 3, 1969.

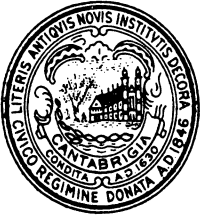

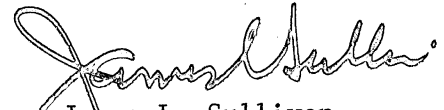
