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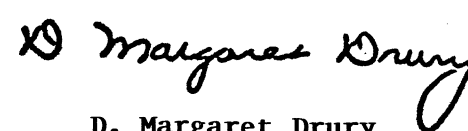

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$1,375 from the Electrical Salaries and Wages Account and \$44,600 from the Electrical Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Electrical Extraordinary Expenditures Account to provide funds for the replacement of the 1980 pickup truck used by the Supervisor of Signal Maintenance and the 1988 sedan used by the City Electrician. The pickup truck is essential for the handling of materials, inspection, repair, and installation of cables, and inspection of utility cables while the utility vehicle is necessary for the City Electrician to perform his duties.
