MEMORANDUM:

It has come to the attention of this City Council that a permit will be requested for the operation of an Auto Body Repair Shop located on Regent Street, and

WHEREAS:

It is the considered opinion of this City Council that the operation of an Auto Body Repair Shop would constitute a threat to the health and safety of the citizens who reside in this neighborhood, and

WHEREAS:

The Health Department Officials have informed this City Council that conditions at this location violate the Health Code due to an accumulation of rubbish and wood in the premises and the presence of rodents in the building and the proposed use of these premises would be detrimental to the environment of this neighborhood, and

WHEREAS:

The presence of junk vehicles on the premises threatens the safety of the children of this area and could be the source of a major conflagration if allowed to remain in this heavily populated residential neighborhood, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the License Commission to withhold the issuance of any license or permit for the operation of an Auto Body Repair Shop at the premises numbered 34-38 Regent Street.
