As we discussed, we believe this community-based effort is important both in the service it is rendering to the homeless and also as a symbol of a community working together to address a vital issue facing all of us.

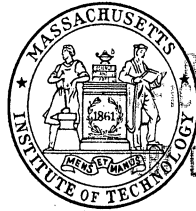
As you know, MIT for its part stands ready to participate in this initiative. We therefore look forward to further discussion on where MIT can best focus its effort in helping to achieve a positive result.

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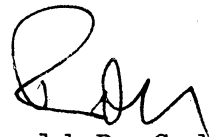
