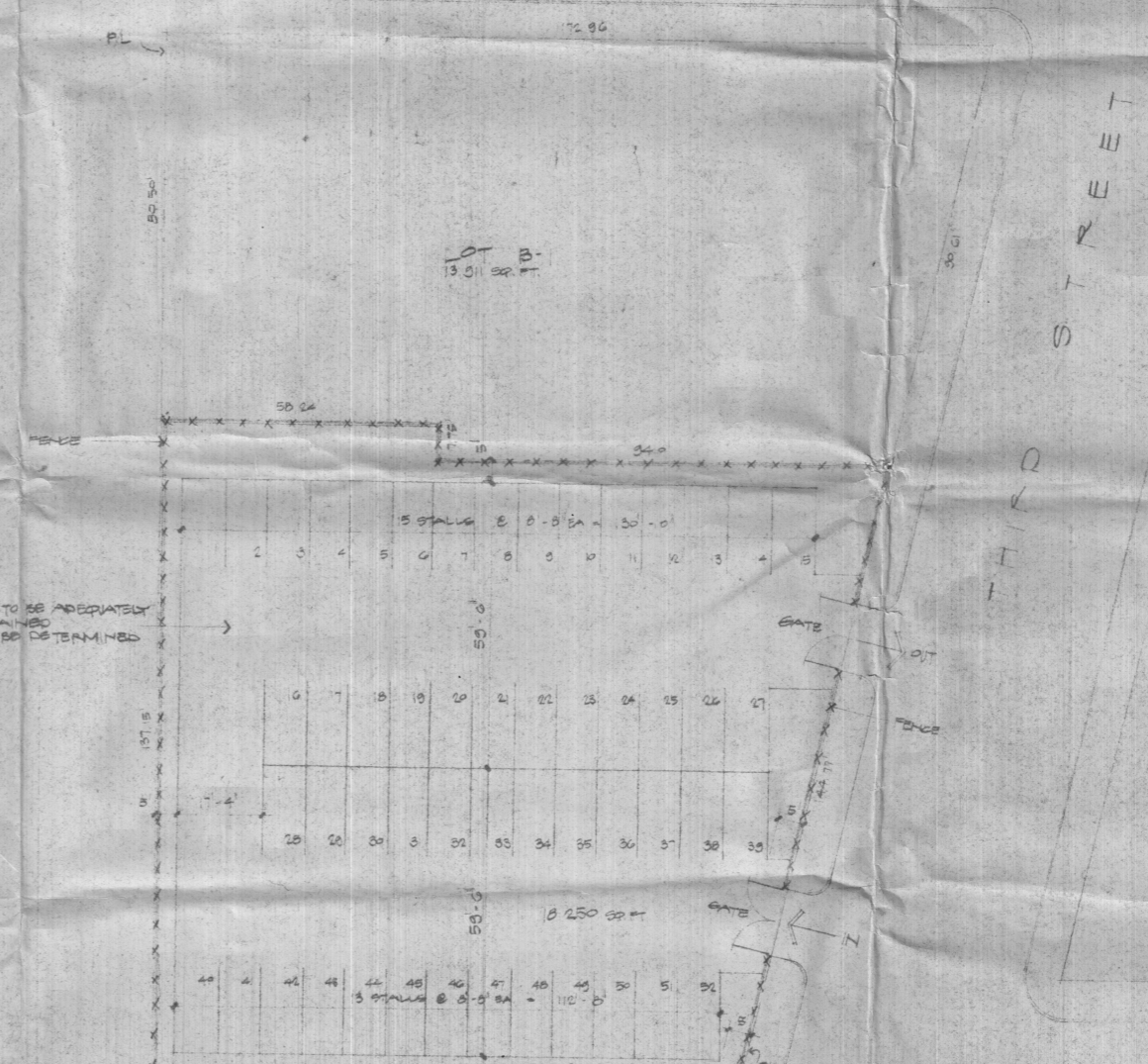


SITE PLAN

IN CITY COUNCIL
October 1, 1973

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works be authorized to grant a permit to William Crane Properties to erect a barricade on the sidewalk on the Northerly side of Bent Street . premises being numbered 179 to 207 for the period of six months during the demolition of buildings and the construction of a garage.

Said permit to be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. A barricade constructed of sturdy steel chain link fence, eight feet high to be erected in the public way, suitably lighted as to prevent any injury to vehicles and pedestrians using these streets.
2. Said obstruction to occupy the entire sidewalk and a minimum of twenty feet will be provided for the safe passage of the vehicles in the one way traffic system that currently exists on said street.
3. The owner or contractor to restore the existing sidewalk to the condition it was prior to the construction or to a better condition.
4. That no existing travel lanes shall be closed until authorized by the Director of Traffic and Parking.
5. That the contractor shall obtain a Temporary Street Construction Permit in addition to all other permits required by the City of Cambridge.
6. That the conditions herein specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge, who may, as he deems necessary, require traffic controls or the use of policemen to facilitate the flow of traffic.
7. The owner and contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of \$10,000.00 indemnifying the City of Cambridge from any liability that may arise from the construction of said barricade during the period of construction.
