1. Resident Parking in Haggerty School Area

The Traffic and Parking Department met with residents of the Strawberry Hill Area concerning the traffic and parking problems in the area. Along with other traffic and parking problems that were discussed was the implementation of the Resident Parking Program in this area. It was decided by the residents at this meeting that the Resident Parking Program would be installed by request only, as they now feel they do not have a serious problem.

At the present time only Fairview Avenue and Oxford Avenue residents have requested that their streets be posted. These will be completed within the next 3 to 4 weeks. I will implement the program on any street in the area that requests it.

2. Blair Place Street Name Sign

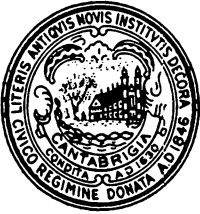
The Traffic Department will install on Blair Place stating that it is a Private Way as well as a Dead End street.

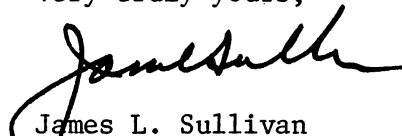
