FROM THE CITY COUNCIL RECORD OF

MONDAY, JUNE 2, 1986

Vice-Mayor Vellucci asked to be recognized by the Chair for the purpose of making a statement.

Upon being recognized by the Mayor, Vice-Mayor Vellucci stated that several weeks ago the City Council, by roll call vote, reaffirmed itself in favor of a Rent Control law in the City of Cambridge.

He further stated at that meeting, Councillor Duehay was not recorded, due to his absence from the Chamber and that it was his belief that Councillor Walsh did not fully understand the order and, consequently, was recorded as present.

At this time, Vice-Mayor Vellucci moved suspension of the rules for the purpose of asking unanimous consent to allow both Councillors Duehay and Walsh, if they so wished, to be recorded on this issue.

Suspension prevailed and at this time, Councillor Duehay stated he wished to be recorded in favor of Vice-Mayor Vellucci's original order of May 12, 1986.

At this time, Councillor Walsh stated he could favor a form of Rent Control, but not the present one. He could support most of the current Rent Control law but not the ordinances and regulations passed subsequently by the City Council. He further stated that changes in the form must occur on this issue.

Furthermore, he at this time indicated he wished to be recorded in favor of the original order of Vice-Mayor Vellucci, dated May 12, 1986.

(PURSUANT TO THE ACTION NOW TAKEN BY THE CITY COUNCIL, THE RECORD OF MAY 12, 1986 WOULD BE AMENDED TO REFLECT A ROLL CALL VOTE OF 9 MEMBERS VOTING IN THE AFFIRMATIVE, NO MEMBERS VOTING IN THE NEGATIVE, NO MEMBERS ABSENT AND NO MEMBERS RECORDED AS PRESENT).
