WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the public safety and convenience require that Brighton Street, between Mount Auburn street and Brighton Bridge, should be widened and laid out forty feet in width,—that Putnam Avenue, between Mount Auburn Street and Western Avenue, should be widened and laid out fifty feet in width,—and that Bridge Street, between Cambridge Street and the Somerville line, should be widened twenty-five feet on the southerly side,—

It is therefore hereby

ORDERED, That due notice be given to the abutters on said Brighton Street, Putnam Avenue and Bridge Street, and all other persons interested, that this Board intends to widen and lay out the Streets before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as public streets, and that
