To the Honorable, the Cambridge City Council:

We the undersigned, as owners and tenants living on Richdale Avenue in Neighborhood Nine, respectfully request that the Cambridge City Council take steps to have approximately 900 feet of sidewalk on Richdale Avenue reconstructed. A list of the specific sidewalk work needed is attached.

The Cambridge Department of Public Works has given a top priority rating to this need. The rating resulted from the streets and sidewalks survey DPW made last year at the request of your Honorable Body. The reconstructed work must be done with City funds, as Neighborhood Nine is not a Block Grant-eligible neighborhood. DPW's cost estimated is \$19,539.

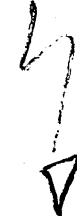

- WHEREAS: This sidewalk is the only sidewalk which has not been reconstructed in Neighborhood Nine, and it is desperately needed, based on an inspection completed by the Public Works Department; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Commissioner of Public Works, with a view in mind of determining the best solution to this problem of repairing the sidewalks on Richdale Avenue.
