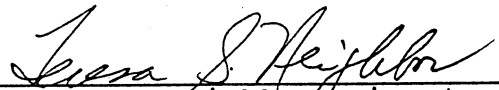

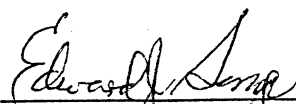

On December 17, 1994 at 10:25 am. Chairman Edward Samp, Jr. reconvened a meeting of the Board of Election Commissioners at Election headquarters, which was a reconvening of a meeting which was recessed on December 16, 1994 at 11:35 p.m. at the conclusion of the redistribution of former City Councillor William Walsh's ballots.

Also present at the meeting were Executive Director Teresa Neighbor, City Solicitor Russell Higley, City Manager Robert Healy and Deputy City Manager Richard Rossi. Commissioner Spears moved and Commissioner Molnar seconded, the Board voted 4 to 0 on the motion: To go into executive session to discuss potential litigation regarding the December 16, 1994 redistribution of former Councillor Walsh's ballots.

The Board recessed at 10:50 am. and began the process of reconstructing the 2182 ballots of former Councillor Walsh.

Moved by Commissioner Molnar, seconded by Commissioner Spears, and voted 4 to 0: To certify the election of Anthony Galluccio as City Councillor following the redistribution of former Councillor William Walsh's ballots.

There was consensus that the City Clerk be notified by the Board in writing, to be delivered by Chairman Samp.

As a result of the reconstruction process it was determined that 19 sequential ballots, numbered 0902 through 0920 were unaccounted for.

As a result, the decision was made to check the ballots of Katherine Triantafillou, whose ballot container was next to the Walsh container during the original count. Commissioners Spears, Bonislowski, and Samp opened the container and discovered at approximately 6:00 p.m. the 19 ballots which were inadvertently placed in the Triantafillou container. The City Manager, Deputy

Manager and City Solicitor were immediately notified of this fact after which the 19 ballots were redistributed and the results of the December 16, 1994 redistribution of the Walsh ballots were amended. The results were as follows:

During the initial redistribution of the 19 ballots Galluccio received 13 votes, McSweeney received 1 vote, Lowett received 1 vote, and Exhausted received 4 votes. The final redistribution of results were as follows: Galluccio received a cumulative total of 13 votes, McSweeney received a cumulative total of 1 vote, and Exhausted received a cumulative total of 5 votes. The final results are as follows: Galluccio received 881 votes being a majority as defined by the statute of the votes so cast, McSweeney received 780 votes and Exhausted received 521 votes for a total of 2182 votes, which was Mr. Walsh's original quota.

Moved, seconded, voted: that the full Board certify the minutes of the meeting of December 17, 1994 and the final results of the Walsh distribution.

Consensus: To seal the 19 sequential ballots in a separate envelope which was sealed, signed by the full Board and placed within the Galluccio container which was then locked, sealed, and secured within the vault.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:46pm.

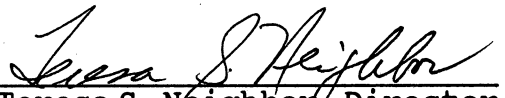
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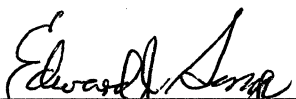
