





POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the RELIANCE INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania, does hereby make, constitute and appoint John J. Curtin, Richard F. Caruso, John J. Curtin, Jr., Mary T. Thompson and Patrick J. Palmisano, individually, of Cambridge, Massachusetts its true and lawful Attorney-in-fact, to make execute, seal and deliver for and on its behalf, and as its act and deed any and all bonds and undertakings of Suretyship,

and to bind the RELIANCE INSURANCE COMPANY thereby as fully and to the same extent as if such bonds and undertakings and other writings obligatory in the nature thereof were signed by an Executive Officer of the RELIANCE INSURANCE COMPANY and sealed and attested by one other of such officers, and hereby ratifies and confirms all that its said Attorney(s)-in-fact may do in pursuance hereof.

This Power of Attorney is granted under and by authority of Article VII of the By-Laws of RELIANCE INSURANCE COMPANY which became effective May 11, 1962, which provisions are now in full force and effect, reading as follows:

ARTICLE VII - Execution of Bonds and Undertakings

SECTION 1. The Board of Directors, the President, or any Vice-President or Assistant Vice-President shall have power and authority to: (a) appoint Attorneys-in-fact and to authorize them to execute on behalf of the Company, bonds and undertakings, recognizances, contracts of indemnity and other writings obligatory in the nature thereof, and (b) to remove any such Attorney-in-fact at any time and revoke the power and authority given to him.

SECTION 2. Attorneys-in-fact shall have power and authority, subject to the terms and limitations of the power of attorney issued to them, to execute and deliver on behalf of the Company, bonds and undertakings, recognizances, contracts of indemnity and other writings obligatory in the nature thereof. The corporate seal is not necessary for the validity of any bonds and undertakings, recognizances, contracts of indemnity and other writings obligatory in the nature thereof.

This power of attorney is signed and sealed by facsimile under and by authority of the following Resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of RELIANCE INSURANCE COMPANY at a meeting held on the 8th day of May, 1959, at which a quorum was present, and said Resolution has not been amended or repealed:

"Resolved, that the signatures of such directors and officers and the seal of the Company may be affixed to any such power of attorney or any certificate relating thereto by facsimile, and any such power of attorney or certificate bearing such facsimile signatures or facsimile seal shall be valid and binding upon the Company and any such power so executed and certified by facsimile signatures and facsimile seal shall be valid and binding upon the Company in the future with respect to any bond or undertaking to which it is attached."

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That the aforesaid

having been appointed by the City Manager of the City of Cambridge one of the Constables within the said City, for the term ending ~~one~~^{three} year from the first Monday in January, 1988, and until another be appointed in his place, now if said Daniel Sutherland shall faithfully exercise all the powers and perform all the duties entrusted to and imposed upon him by the laws of the Commonwealth and the ordinances of the City of Cambridge; shall carefully intend the preservation of the peace, the discovery and prevention of all attempts against the same; shall duly execute all warrants which shall be sent unto him from lawful authority, and faithfully attend to all such directions in the laws and orders of Court, as are or shall be committed to his care; shall comply with the orders and directions of the City Manager and Council, which shall be passed from time to time for the regulation of the Constables; shall faithfully and with what speed he can, collect and levy all such fines, distresses, rates, assessments, and sums of money for which he shall have sufficient warrants according to law, rendering an account thereof, and paying the same according to the direction in his warrant; and also, if he shall faithfully perform all the duties of a Constable in the service of all civil processes which may be committed to him, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.
