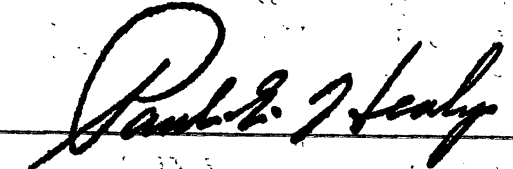

- WHEREAS: Edward J. Murphy, General Manager of Sears Roebuck & Company served as President of the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce during the years of 1982 to 1984; and
- WHEREAS: Ed was born in Haverhill and is a graduate of Somerville High School and Boston College and began his employment with Sears in 1960, holding different positions of varying responsibility prior to being named General Manager; and
- WHEREAS: Ed, while serving as Vice-President of the Chamber, concentrated his efforts on economic development and was instrumental in the establishment of the Chamber's own development corporation (Cambridge Economic Development), which provides long term financing of up to twenty-five years to eligible business applicants for expansion, renovation, or the purchase of equipment having a life expectancy of up to fifteen years; and
- WHEREAS: Ed Murphy has demonstrated leadership, understanding, fairness and intuitive thinking during his tenure as President of the Chamber, qualities which should not go unnoticed; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its gratitude to Mr. Edward Murphy for his tireless efforts on behalf of the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Ed on behalf of the entire City Council.
