In Board of Aldermen, Dec 21<sup>st</sup> 1870

Whereas.

It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Prince Street so called from Magazine to Pleasant Street be laid out as a public way..

Ordered, That said Prince Street be and hereby is laid out and established as a public way, by the name of Prince Street agreeably to a plan thereof drawn by the City Engineer bearing date of June 23<sup>d</sup> 1870 and now before this Board, to wit from Magazine to Pleasant Street the same to be Thirty feet in width as shown by the red lines delineated on said plan,  
Ordered,

That no damages be awarded to the persons over whose land said Prince Street is laid out as aforesaid.
