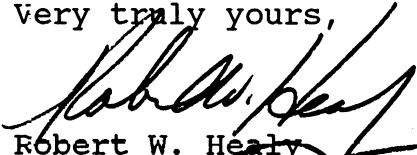

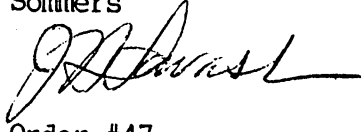

Council Order #47 concerns insufficient ventilation in the two restrooms of the adult day care facility at 105 Windsor Street.

I have investigated the situation and it appears that duct work will have to be installed from the basement level to the first floor. At the first floor level a wall penetration and exhaust fan will be required to remove the air from the bathrooms. The mechanical portion of the building code requires dedicated exhaust air for bathrooms, and this plan would satisfy the requirement.

I suggest that we wait until the new HVAC contract is in place (approximately October 15). Their mechanics should be able to do the work in less than two weeks following the contract award.



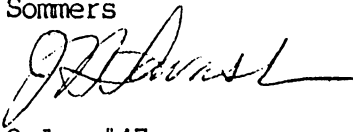
