- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to arrange for an appropriate sign to be posted on the front lawn at City Hall which would indicate to those individuals who may have employment opportunities for our older Americans to contact the Elder Hire Office, 15 Pearl Street, Cambridge, MA, 868-0800.
