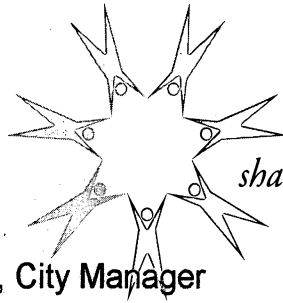

In response to Council Order #139, dated September 14, 1998, RE: Report on This Year's Summer Food Program, the following is offered:

The Summer Food Service Program is a federally funded program, administered by the State Department of Education, designed to provide nutritious meals for children during the summer months when school is not in session. The city of Cambridge has sponsored this program for the past eighteen years, operating an increasing number of food sites each year. DHSP contracts with the School Department Food Services to prepare and deliver breakfast, lunch and snacks to sites throughout the City. Meals are served at many of the Cambridge parks and the two MDC pools, as well as many Community School programs and summer camps.

During the summer of 1998, thirty-four food sites were operated. In the month of July, which is the largest operating month, 1,570 children were served. (1,570 reflects a 17% increase over last July.) August figures have not been compiled yet, but during June and July the following number of meals were served:
